## THE CAMPAIGN FOR CHATHAM COLLEGE: A VISION OF TOMORROW

The past has been honored and the present assured. It's time now to build the future.

How to begin? With a Campaign that will revitalize the College's infrastructure—the physical, financial, and academic foundations of educational excellence.

The Campaign for Chatham College, which will raise \$21 million over three years, has been well launched, with initial contributions of more than \$9 million by trustees, alumnae, and other friends of the College.

Now it is the turn of other members of the Chatham community to keep the vision splendid.

## RENEWING THE CAMPUS

*\$13 million*

Chatham's campus is still distinctively beautiful—but some of the facilities in which teaching, learning, and living occur are at best constrained and at worst showing the effects of deferred maintenance.

It has been a half-century since Chatham's last extensive building projects, and a quarter-century since the last new building—the library—was constructed. More recently, the sale of property a decade ago and enrollment growth over the last few years have contributed to the current shortage of space.

The College has developed a Facilities Master Plan—a meticulous blueprint for meeting both immediate and longer-term needs. According to the plan,
